#### Resources

- Newspaper
- Tape
- Coloured paper
- Card
- Cups (paper or plastic)
- Craft glue/hot glue gun
- Pom pom balls
- Clear cellophane or clear contact

## Paper Fish

#### Materials

- Coloured paper
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Coloured pencils/texters
- Glue

#### Instructions

- 1. Cut a rectangular strip of paper
- 2. Draw on a tail on the end inch
- 3. Cut the tail out (making sure to not separate completely)
- 4. Fold in half but do not push down
- 5. Trace the fish tail onto the bottom half and cut out
- 6. Unfold and decorate the fish scales and draw on eyes and a mouth on one half of the rectangle
- 7. Cut out small fins of a different colour paper and decorate before gluing on.
- 8. Glue the back end together and allow to dry.





# Basketball cup hoop craft

#### Materials

- Card
- Cup (plastic or paper)
- Texters
- Glue (craft or hot glue)
- Pom poms
- Scissors

#### Instructions

- 1. Cut a backboard shape out of the card
- 2. Draw a rectangle on the card backboard
- 3. Draw a net design on the cup
- 4. Optional cut the bottom of the cup out so the ball can go through
- 5. Glue the cup to the backboard using craft glue or hot glue
- 6. Allow students to trial their game after it dries with pom poms



# **Magnifying glass craft**

## Materials

- Template
- Texters
- Scissors
- Glue
- Clear cellophane or clear contact

## Instructions

- 1. Colour the magnifying glass template
- 2. Cut the outside and inside sections out
- 3. Glue the cellophane to the back of the template
