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




# Minecraft Selfies


## Draw a Minecraft Selfie




Supplies: Grid paper, Black marker, Crayons




1. Count boxes to find the center line. Use math or estimate and check.




2. Draw two symmetrical eyes.




3. Draw a symmetrical mouth.




4. Start the bottom of the head.



5. Draw the hair line.



6. Draw a neck and body.



7. Finish the outer hair line.

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# Glove Craft

## Materials:

- Gloves (one for each child)
- Measuring Bowl (or something to mix water colouring in, and then pour into glove)
- Food Colouring/Dye
- Elastic Bands
- Something to mix the food dye in the water.

## Instructions:

- Give each child one glove.
- One by one, fill the bowl with water, and then add the desired food colouring.
- Mix the food colouring in the water so it blends.
- Carefully pour the coloured water into the child's glove.
- Tie the top of the glove with an elastic band.



## Pom Pom Basketball Courts

### Materials:

- Card Paper
- Pom Poms
- Texters
- Scissors

### Instructions:

- On a large piece of paper or card board, draw a line down the centre to represent the mid-field point on your basketball court.
- Next, draw the relevant court outlines to make a basketball court.
- Take a small cardboard box, and cut it in half. Place on half of the box at each end of the field as goal nets.
- Place a pom pom (your basketball) in the centre of the field.
