- With the river sitting on the floor/table, encourage children to construct a LEGO bridge. If there are multiple children, they can join their rivers and make multiple bridges.






# Draw a Minecraft Selfie




Supplies: Grid paper, Black marker, Crayons




Count boxes to find the center line.
Use math or estimate and check.




2. Draw two symmetrical eyes.




3. Draw a symmetrical mouth.




4. Start the bottom of the head.




5. Draw the hair line.

## **Glove Craft**

#### **Materials:**

- o Gloves (one for each child)
- o Measuring Bowl (or something to mix water colouring in, and then pour into glove)
- o Food Colouring/Dye
- o Elastic Bands
- o Something to mix the food dye in the water.

### Instructions:

- o Give each child one glove.
- o One by one, fill the bowl with water, and then add the desired food colouring.
- o Mix the food colouring in the water so it blends.
- o Carefully pour the coloured water into the child's glove.
- Tie the top of the glove with an elastic band.





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
## **Pom Pom Basketball Courts**

### **Materials:**

- o Card Paper
- o Pom Poms
- o Texters
- o Scissors

### Instructions:

- o On a large piece of paper or card board, draw a line down the centre to represent the mid-field point on your basketball court.
- o Next, draw the relevant court outlines to make a basketball court.
- Take a small cardboard box, and cut it in half. Place on half of the box at each end of the field as goal nets.
- o Place a pom pom (your basketball) in the centre of the field.



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
