- Small paper plates
- Kids <u>plastic beads</u>
- Colored cardstock
- Googly eyes
- Scissors
- Crayons
- Craft glue
- 1. Draw a snail head onto your cardstock with upper tentacles for the eyes
- 2. Glue the googly eyes on the upper tentacles
- 3. Draw on the face
- 4. Draw a swirl/spiral on the paper plate
- 5. Glue beads on the line
- 6. Glue the snail head to the paper plate



Paper Chain Caterpillar

Materials

* Various Sheets of Colored Cardstock (Red, Green and Black)

* Hand-Held Office Stapler

* Basic Craft Scissors

* Large Wiggle Eyes – two per caterpillar craft

* School Glue

Steps

- 1. First grab your red cardstock, green cardstock and scissors.
- 2. Cut out FOUR long strips out of the green and ONE long strip out of the red.
- **3.** One by one, staple and intertwine your cardstock "chain" together, with the red {the caterpillar's head} in the front and the green being the body.
 - **4.** When done set aside.
 - **5.** Next grab your black cardstock and scissors.
 - **6.** Cut out a simple pair of antennas for your craft.
- **7.** To finish off the *Paper Chain Caterpillar*, glue your wiggle eyes and black cardstock antennas to the "head" of the craft.







Badge Craft

Materials

- Card
- Foil
- Permanent marker
 - Scissors
 - Glue

Steps

- 1. Cut the card into the shape of a badge
 - 2. Apply glue to the front of the badge
- 3. Place foil on the glued side of the badge
- 4. Let it dry and tuck the foil in behind the badge
- 5. Write with the name with the permanent marker
