- 4. Hot glue the wheels on and it's ready to play with. Vroom Vroom!






Halloween Treat Covers

Spooky expanding ghost



- Empty water bottle
- Balloon
- Small funnel
- 1 Tablespoon baking soda
- 1/2 cup vinegar
- Permanent marker (for drawing on a face optional)
- Pour 1/2 cup of vinegar into an empty water bottle.
- Draw a face on your balloon if you'd like while it's deflated.
- Place the funnel into the open end of the deflated balloon and pour in the baking soda.
- Secure the open end of the balloon onto the top of the bottle being careful not to dump the contents of the balloon into the bottle quite yet.
- When you're ready, hold the balloon upright allowing the baking soda to fall into the bottle and mix with the vinegar.

## <u>Friday</u>

Pipe cleaner spiders



- 4 black pipe cleaners
- A pair of googley eyes
- PVA glue
- Scissors

1. Cut two of the pipe cleaners in half to make four smaller lengths, and bunch them together.

2. Wrap the other two full pipe cleaners around the centre of the bunch to make the spider's body.

**3**. You should now have a 'body' and four straight 'legs' either side. Shape each leg by bending twice as shown in the picture, and fan out the legs a little.

4. Glue on a pair of googley eyes onto the spiders body.

# Human, Human, Zombie

Instead of Duck, Duck, Goose, players are either humans or zombies. The children sit on the ground spread out in a large circle. One child is selected to be the first zombie. They walk around the outside of the circle and lightly tap each player on the head labeling them either "human" or "zombie." The first player to be labeled zombie is now infected. The newly infected player gets up and chases the one who zombified him around the circle. The first one back to the open space in the circle is cured. The other player repeats the process. The game ends when everyone has had a turn to be a zombie.
